

8. Transcription of colophon	<i>Rig 'tshan ['dzin] 'a pha khyi dmar ris blo yul lha srin dam la rtags dus mdzad pa'o// bkra shis/ mangalam/ dge'o/</i>
9. Translation of colophon	Written by the knowledge-holder 'A pha Khyi dmar ri when he subdued the gods in Lo Montang.
10. General remarks	'A pha (pronounced "Awa") is an obsolete name for the area of what is now northern Lo in which Monthang is located. Khyi dmar ri is the actual clan name of the Drangsong priestly lineage.
11. Remarks on script	Inexpert <i>dpe tshugs</i> throughout.
12. Format	<i>Deb ther</i> sewn at the top and folded once more in half parallel to the long edge at the spine
13. Size	12.5 × 19 cm
14. Layout	6–10 text lines per page, excepting the upper cover with 2 lines and bottom cover with 4 lines
15. Illustrations and decorations	None
16. Paper type	Woven with coarse textile sieve print
17. Paper thickness	0.06–0.10 mm
