He rents a piece of land here just to keep ~~his cattle~~ cattle on this spot. ~~There is~~ The place suits cattle-breeding - there is plenty of pasture grounds here and plenty of water.

The steer kept on a rope nearby is not his own. He took it from a man to keep it and feed for a time. The steer was valued L.12 at the moment he took it.
