As to the absense of several persons on the list I was given my information by Samuel Allen, and Millicent they did not remember any of these people, but as they were young at the time they may be mistaken. the parents were at work but Samuel haspromised to check up.

House::

The house is a two room structure and is made of thatch, in the house there are four beds, the family seems fairley well taken care of judging from the amount of rented land and livestock.

Land::

The house is on one acre of ground on which is planted in cane, yams, and bananas. all these are market produce, the food for the family, the daughter guessed that the monetary output per week was one pound. Beside this land they rent five acres more of Allsides land, on which is planted, three acres of cane, one and one half acres of yams, and a half acre of bananas. All for the purpose of marketing.

Family::

The family originated in Allsides and has always been here. The Girl Millicent had a child for one green, and he is now in Mandeville.

The whole family is Wesleyans.

Land: Rent 5 1/4 acres on Allsides in 4 pieces. Buy Land: They bought 5 acres "down at Troy @ £5 an acre from Aubrey Turner it is back land and it dont finish pay for. We want house spot now, that land is too far back".

Crops: Yams, yellow and negro, cane "bananabad only one, one roots leave and they are still going. The sugar is profitable sometimes. The sticks ofr the yams are very hard to get £1 a 100, sometimes you have to use 2 sticks together".

Marketing: Yam time I go to Lowland market in St. Ann, plenty of us hire truck. Now I take escellion, sugar head and such to Stewart Town, no market not there, is just a little village and I use the beast. I have to buy these things sometimes and sell them over. I used to go to Balachva market but Lowland suit me better. The speculatoñ come same place here and buy ~~the~~ yam, when I not going to market.

House: It put up long, long time ago, all the children born right here. Since I live here we have about 4 different houses on the same spot.

Gradd children : Ellen has 1 daughter Phyllis Clarke, the father Hazel Clarke has not given anything ~~to~~ towards her support for about 6 months.

There are several grandchildren, ~~but~~ I visited them twice but was unable to get much information concerning them.
