Interview with Lucille Vance& Johnathan Vance

Lucille is the daughter of Mabel Perkins and Phillip Brooks . She was along with her grandmother, when she was very small, but later on she went to her mother in Kingston . She started to go to school here, and then finished here schooling in Kingston. She read to the 4th standard .

After leaving school she was doing domestic's work with Teacher Buggis, getting 6/- per week. Later on she worked with Mrs Thompson at 2/6 per day. In 1943 her grand mother Clementina took sick so she came home to take care of her. he has been living here since. he goes to Kingston now and then to see her mother, who lives in Kingston.

She met Amerikanx Jonathan in Bull Savannah when she came in 1943. They became friends, and were living together for a long time. Their were married in June last year. She is 28.

Jonathan is from Clarendon. He works with the Public Work's Department as a "watch man". After leaving Clarendon, he worked in Mandeville, and from Mandeville he came to Bull Savannah.

His parents are Clemetia Fearon and Lewis Vance. He did not go to school for long "couple days, a/me no like i' a de old people dem fault. Few day in every year. Ha' fe stop and look after the pickneyx smaller pickney, me was the kar oldest". He is 35. He came here in 1943.

He has a child by Myrtle Wilkison from Clarendon. The child is Dalbert , he is staying here with his father and stepmother . He is with them for four years.

He makes Ice-cream and sells every day at the factory. He buys a block of ice for 4/- and a box of cones for 4/-. He sells the ice cream at 5d per cone "I' don ' pay so greatly but eh better then sit down." At present he is not selling the cream himself. He pasy a boy 7/- per week to sell for him. He has been/sategoxit/for three years.

Simpson Lenard and Simpson Jarrett /now ab. 13 and 10 years old/were for Lodrick Simpson. son of Alice Sinclair, now c.l.wife of Hubert Powell /F.R. 164/. Lodrick Sim pson - according to Dudley Simpson - is living now with his step-father and mother. He is about 40. Brooks Pamela was for Cyril Brooks - son of Nicholas Brooks - in Thatch Walk. In 1942 these three children lived in Edith's grandmother home. N according to her, they are living with their fathers. However No no Pamela Brooks /Supposed to be Cyril's daughter/ is found in Nicholas Brooks household. We don't manxaxastixxxhta know also whether Lodrick Simpson is really living with his grand his children at his mother's home. /i.e Hubert Powell's home in Overroad/.

> After her grandmother's daits death Edith Brooks was along with Ernest Ward /see F.R. 170/. According to what Ernest Ward fami says she had one child for Ernest Ward - the child stays now in with the father. Think According to what Edith Brooks says she had two children for Ernest Ward - both staying with her. This arrangement might have been recently changed.

> Ernest Brx Ward and Edith Brooks were living together for a period of time in a little house opposite Broomfield's shop. They rented this house from Theodore Holness. Recently Theodore Holness asked Ernest Ward to remove. Ernest Ward is staying with Melona Ward /3 years old/ atxhisxxxxithxhis at his grandmother's home, Rachel Powell, in Cverroad. Whereabouts of Edita Brooks are unknown - she probabyl is, staying her with her half sister Lucille Brooks /now Vance/ in the old home of her grandmother late grandmother Clementine Witter.
