Simpson Calvin his parents and relatives in Shadock Hill. His land.

Simpson Calvin is son of Zada Simpson and her first husband, Kennedy Simpson, that died in Cuba. Izan Simpson is Calvin's uncle. He was Kennedy's brother.

"Simpson Calvin - him call Izan Simpson Uncle. He son of this Kennedy Simpson that die in Cuba. And Zada Simpson."

Simpson Clavin lives on the land which was passed to him from his father's property.

Calvin Simpson is living in his old paternal home and for from the land that was passed to him by his late father.

Previously he lived in this house with his mother Zada Simpson, who in the meantime married Lewi Simpson. Lehi Simpson, his father-in-law, lived with all the family together. He had he house of his own. When Calvin grew older Lehi Simpson built his own house on the other side of the path and moved to this house together with zama Zada, Calvin's mother, and with their children.

"After Kennedy's match death, Zada Simpson marry to Lehi Simpson. They have lots of children. But Calvin Simpson become the man. He put it to Lehi Simpson: I cant keep you in my father home, you must go and build your mun house. So lehi Simpson built the house and took Zada Simpson. Calvin was heir ixufu lawful of his father estate."

Calvin Simpson is married and has children. "Calvin Simpson - him a married man. Him marry to a girl from Chocolate Hole: Lilian Banton. Have two children."

His land is estimated by Dudley Simpson at about 3 acres. "He own around 3 acre probably." Nobody else besides his wife and children is living in their

He is a cultivator - has no other profession or occupation. He is a successful cultivator and inspite of his young age does mandament well and supports fully his family.

Calvin Simpson. His wife Lilian Banton. Their children. His cousins - Simpson Jehu and Lucas. "Him is a young boy. Shouldnt be married man at all. Too young. Responsibilities are worse than him is big. Still them trying the best of life. He cultivate hard, tomato and so on. His tomato - the crop turned nice - not mad, made a few pounds."

Two Simpsons, who were living with Calvin in his house in 1942/43, are his cousins. Jehu is known better under his nickname "Crosby". Lucas is called "Yucal".

"Yucal and Crosby is two brother. Crosby madx Yucal is to call Kennedy Simpson, Galvin's father, uncle. Crosby is not living together with Calvin Simpson now. He living now with Lehi Simpson. Lehi Simpson is his next uncle by mother side."

Dudley does not know who is or might be Mills Hilda who stayed in this house in in 1943. "The only Hilda that I know kixingxxix bakkom is living at Bottom. She is married to James Simpson at Bottom. Wasnt living with Yucal or Crosby at all."

Visit at home. Interv. Calvin and Lilian Simpson. 26.6.48.

I met Calvin Simpson in his uncab's (Izan Simpson) yard. Izan's yard is a kind of cross roads meeting place for people am from both sides of the hill and during my talk with Izan & family a lot of people gathered round us "hen I was offering round cigarettes I hesitated before I offered one to Calvin. He looked so young that I thought he might not smoke yet - at least "officialy". Martha "impson promptly said: "This is Calvin Simpson" I knew who he was and explained why I hesitated, so he wouldn't feel slighted. Martha laughed: "You thought he is a young irresponsible boy and he is a family man." Calvin smiled and pointing to a little boy who was clinging to his knees

said "That's my eldest".

After I finished my visit at Izan's, Calvin took me to his home. Pointing to a building with two doors he said: "That's the kitchen and buttery" and pointing to the house "And this is my new house." I looked into the kitchen from where a child's whiperings could be heard. Lil lian Simpson was sitting on the bench and feeding with the spoon her younger son wilbert. She was giving him what looked like mashed yam and the child didn't want to eat. Seeing us she stopped feeding the child and came out of the kitchen. They took me a few paces farther to the house but didn't invite to come in. Lillian explained rather nervously that the furniture didn't come yet. "The furniture is still at my mother's home." She told me about this coming furniture several times implying that the one they have can't be considered furniture at all. The door to one of the rooms was open. I could see a very large bed covered waitaxx with a white fresh sheet, a little table, some chairs. I thought it looked comfortable and not overcrowded like in most homes.

calvin pointed to the thatched roof and explained that this is the good quality big thatch. The house - he said- is not really yet finished, it was started only this season. Previously he lived in the old house which was built by his father. He showed me the spot behind the new house. But the house was old and "no good". He pulled it down. Behind the new house there is still another little one-room building. This serves also as a kind of buttery-spare room. In this homestead lives Calvin with his small family:

I was told already xxxx alittle about Calvin's story by his uncle Izan. Calvin is the son of KennedyS impson who died. His mother Zada (daughter of Francella impson) married after Kennedy's death Lehi Simpson, who house is

almost opposite Calvin's accross the road. Zada died a few few years ago. Calvin said he had one sister who died. (full sister). His mother had many children with her second husband. (see F.R. 14)

Lilian Simpson is the daughter of Birdie Dyer She didn't want to tell or ratheravoided the question who was her father. Lilian says that her mother lives "over the hill" which might be either Tad Town or Chocolate Hole. he sad she didn't have neither brothers nor sisters. It was obvious she didn't want to talk about her family matters. They married 3 years ago.

The land. Calvin says he has 72 acres of land which he got of his "father estate". He cultivates it himself He had this year 6000 tomatoes and is satisfied with the price he got. He has 52 acres at home and 2 acres in the wad woods. But lot of this land is stony and can't be used for cultivation. Calvin speaks with modesty but pleasure about his work. He kasvabsukvavacrexaf plants cassava, ga congo peas and corn - about 2 acre each. Also 2 acr. of red peas. One acre of granea grass which he considers as important as cassava. Of these cultivations he has a certain surplus which he sells.

His big well kept donkey was under the mango tree. He has two pigs and two goats.

All his cash he made from tomatoes and from selling other produce was used to build the new house.
