Reginald Swaby is the son of William and Alice Swaby. Alice Swaby is the daughter of old Jane Lawrence .Old William Swaby is from Low Lands. He was a fish erman and settled in Bull Savannah by marrying (first c.l.) Alice. They have three sons and one daughter alive: Reginald - the oldest: Clarence married and lives in Top Hill and Ferdie who lives in the yard of a neighbour Dorrel Dyer but is still linked with the paternal home.

Mavis Jacob is "from Junction way". She came to Bull Savannah around seven years ago. Her father is Edward Jacob and mother Violette Collins. She has three brothers and three sisters; only one sister is her full sibling, all the others are her half siblings on the mother side. None of her family lives in Bull-avannah.

Their married life.

Reginald and Mavis started to live together about 6 years ago. Shevworksvaixthuxfautoryxdurkugvkhevuvuuu. They lived always in rented rooms. Their last rented pla place was at Izan Simpson's, they came to live with Sara rah Simpson a few months ago. Especially Reginald complaint about this constant moving and living in rented places. He hopes however to settle soon on his own. He bought one acre of land in Dunder Hill from Albert Neil and is building his own house there, which he expects to finish perhaps this summer and move there with the family.

Means of subsistence.
Reginald's father has only one acre of land which is worked by his sons, for which they get a share. his however doesn't amount to much. Reginal works "other's people land" on shares. It is only for the past year he has his own one acre of land.

Mavis works during the season in the fautory. Out of season she earns some money by pleating which she sells by the yard to a "rs. Dyer from hocolate Hole.

Their occupations during my visits.

I met Mavis Jacob during my first visit to "Bottom". She was sitting in the company of Sarah Simpson and her daughter in law Lydia Ford. Sarah and Lydia were busy shelling beans. Mavis was pleating the straw palm-leaf "straw". This occupation is characteristic for the women in this tiny settlement. Mavis was clad more soignee than the other women there, her behaviour also was more restrained than/the straightforward and homely women living in the neighbouring homes.

I met Reginald on my second visit to Bottom. He was busy with other men to put a new thatch on James Powell's kitchen. His old father William Swaby came for the occasion from Shaddock Hill and was watching the men working, sitting in the yard and smoking his pipe. Reginald and all the other neighbours who helped ames with the thatching had their breakfast at ames home. They aren't paid for their work. It is a neighbourly service, which is returned when occasion arises.

Reginald said he had a hard start in life. He didn't go to America and his father wasn't able to help him much. He did go to the Bull Savannah school but didn't finish its whole course as he had to help the father being the oldest of the children.
