Stanley live at Alligator Pond now, with him sweetheart. If you know how the man them run 'bout the whole world, noh time to stop yet. When Mr Sickness come and Mr. Death come them have to stop. Daisy

Was born in Manchester, her mother got her while she was working in Manchester. She came to live in Bull Savannah when she was a baby. She grew with her mother. Her father did not support her. She does not "even know me father". She started to work when she was about 13 years old. She was not sent to school, "for me mother was poor, and couldnt manage fe send me. Them never particular fe send pickney a school that time, for the place no did enlighten as now. Me only use to go to Sunday School a Bull Savannah Church. Me never go dey this long time".

Daisy started to work, washing clothes for people at 6d per day. She worked for Mrs Violet Lewis, Mrs Lilly Roy, and now she is working with Mrs Clemmie Francis, at 1/-6 per day. She has been working there for about two years.

Daisy is 20 years old. She has two children for Stanley Roy, son of Clemmie Francis. Stanley was living in Bull Savannah, but has removed to Alligator Pond, and is living with Betsy Martin. Daisy and Stanley were not living together in a house. They be-friends and she has the children for him. Stanley has the first child, and Daisy has the other. The names

of the children are , Enid Pansy ^Roy , and Euclen Agatha Roy . Euclen is about foru years old . Stanley does not help Daisy with ^{Euclen} , as he has the other child to support . "When me fall with the first baby , me mother quarrel and say me have fe leave the yard . She find out a week after me have the "stomach " that me fall . Stanley go talk to me mother and she make me stay and have the baby a fe her house !

She had both her children at her mother's yard. At present she is not living at her mother's ^{home} . She lives at Bottom istrict . She left her mother's house three months ago and went to livd in a house she rents from David Brooks at 2/- per month . She left her mother home because "the house too full up and caan hole, too much people dey one place " . She told her mother she would be leaving, and her mother consented .

She does not cook at her own house . Her mother prepares her meals at Daisy's mother's house . Daisy gives her mother money to provide for her . She "only sleep a fe me house , me and Euclen " . He does not have a boy friend .

Now and then when she can afford it , she gives her grand mother Louise Rowe (see F. R. 184) a 3d or a 6d. Daisy and Stanley parted , "because him leave me and go take 'nother woman " .
