She stayed for one year and a half , teaching with Teacher Millard. She was suffering with her throat and the talking ~~x~~ at school was too much for her , so she gave up teaching and ~~xxxx~~ went to work with the Jamaica Welfare after she left Bull Savannah.

She does not know what kind of work Sybil is doing with the Ja. Welfare. She passed through Bull Savannah once after she left.

Sybil's maid ~~xxxx~~ Mary Beason left a little time before Sybil. "She ~~xx~~ alone come and two a them go back. Mary became pregnant for Urel Witter of Bull Savannah. Witter would not pay any attention to Mary , so she had to go home. Mary is from Linstead . She was about 31 at the time. After Mary left she wrote to Neris once¹.
