Linda, now aged 12 who was rocking the baby in the bedroom:

I offered to take it myself to see the doctor but she said if she took it today / it was then 5 p.m. / it would have the night air and cough worse than ever. She would take it on Friday but and again she re-iterated that she had never "been at" before the "month was up", so I said I would come for it on Friday or send Nerissa if she would trust it to Nerissa. She said she would. The child is ill.

Sat on the bank while O. talked to Ludus Bailey who was slightly drunk and Zachariah Smith both of whom were spinning him the story of their lives. Drew masterpieces of the children which the mother laughed at.
