House on right, going towards Warsop from U.Sp. off main road. Three rooms. Fair sized living room well furnished. Front door closed but invited in. Crocus bag on floor half-filled with peas which the family were shelling.

Occupants (seen) : -

1. Mr G. elderly, very much in background and silent. Owner of house. Has farm (owned? rented?) on Allsides. Allowz Allen houseroom.
2. Miss A. Energetic, talkative, dominant personality. Described herself as widow (?).
3. Valentine (m). child of Miss(?) Anglin.
4. Lebert. (m) ditto (by same father)
5. Kita. (Iona) ditto ditto
6. Another girl unnamed. Adopted? or neighbours? or Grandison's? (She said "a grandchild of G's").

Lebert sitting on ground with neck and face tied up. Mother said he had mumps and was "sick with his feet for long time". Told him to get up when spoken to and dragged him to his feet. Said doctor wanted him to have injections but he would not go for hem so doctor was trying to get him into hospital for her "where he would have to have them". All time, Kita showing off, laughing and squirming and darting out and under the sofa with other small girl, picking at our skirts. Mother said she was "still naughty" and "still wet her bed". (See under ASHMAN) She wanted to get someone "to take her" but on account of the # bed-wetting she could not let her go far. Spoke sympathetically. Tried to make child stand up to speak to us but Kita let her legs hang flabbily and refused to stand, still giggling. Was again told she was "naughty".

A. said children all of one father who died six years ago. They had had land at Allsides but on his death she was turned off and had nowhere to go. "This gentleman" (G) had given her houseroom. She worked on his land. And looked after house. Informative. Interests to invoke sympathy & help for children.
