Mr Bailey volunteered that he and been a most promi ing scholar at school -- he had risen to be a monitor at t ; esleyan school, and wished and hoped to go on to secc lary but the times had not allowed him to "promote himself" was blind, old and again the plaint. He did not live here. He lived in a house on New H d. But his daughter was washing a shirt for him and he had co : to get it and put it on. Someone had led him here across
