So, since the Census was taken Lorenzo has set up his wn home. Mrs Julian McDonald is some relative of the Baileys th ough Samuel Bailey the brother of the blind man, Francis bu I am afraid my notes here are indecipherable.

The house and land ~~xxxx~~ belong to Mrs McDonald and ere bought from Alice Swaby on Newoads. This, where Mrs Mc D. 1 ves is ~~xxxxxx~~ elsewhere on Allsides I thin. But this household needs sorting out I am afraid.

Ada White and Lorenzo have 3 children -- all Frazers:  
 Islin Agatha; Winnifred and Carmel.

The land where they live is  $\frac{3}{4}$  acre and was bought from Mr Ignatius Dixon last year for £18.10. (He sells at £18 per acre).  
 The new thatch house going up is for her adopted mother Mrs Case who lives with them. The five of them at present live in the older house. Also thatch but well made.
