Mrs Kennedy is over 60 and frail and thin. She says s : came from Cayman. Her husband was sent over to Jamaica -- ne was a teacher and sht came with him. Her husband is dead, S ; stays here as she has the place and can earn a living here .th her sewing. She would like to go back to cayman on a visi but not to stay. She could not earn her living there by sewi there everybody can sew and makes their own clothes.

She had five children. They are all grown-up and go e away except Blossom who lives with her. Blossom has a lit e baby. She is not married but the name of the father was not iven and as there were two young girls working in the room did not ask. Blossom gave the child's name as "Karl" and v en I said "Karl what?" she said "Just Karl". He is 7 months and is coloured.

Mrs K. says one of her daughters is married to a Sa itary Inspector (name of Siblis?) and they have j ust been m ved

to Savanna La Mar (Farm Pen district).

Mrs K. says she gets more work to do than she can m nage. She pointed to a small table in the room onand under wich were piles of material w aiting to be made up into shi ts pants and dresses. She referred to the materials as "r gs She says now she is getting old she cannot work so dui kly so the work piles up. She had two girls working in the room where there was a sewing machine on the bed. one girl as cutting out a small boy's trousers. The other was usin the machine. Mrs K. said the former was making her own thi gs and had come to her to show her how to. She did a lot f that. Anyone who wanted to come to her and learn she wo ld t ach them. The other girl told me she was "an apprentice". Her name was Gloria Gordon. The first girl's name was Amy Fergu on.

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
