Turnissa, married wife of Winston, was "Senior at first." She is from Ballard's Valley.

"Turnissa Senior is the sister of Eustace Senior. Both of them is from Ballard's Valley."

Holness Winston and Turnissa Senior - "in Ballard's Valley they met". Winston was "coming to visit her brother", who lives in Thatch Walk. "And then them met. And Winston ~~xxx~~ Holness go to Ballard's Valley and visit Turnissa father and mother."

The house in Bottom Bull-Savannah is about a hundred yards from the main road leading to Junction. There are three houses in close vicinity there where the widow and descendants of Uriah Holness live.

The house of Winston Holness is rather poor. It is a two-room building not in a too good repair.

Between the path and the kitchen there is a shed. Turnica and all the children were in the kitchen finishing their dinner. The father didn't come yet from the woods where he went to prepare ~~tomato~~ the ground for tomato garden with his brother Cedrick. Turnica was eager to return to dinner so I couldn't keep her long. Present household:

(I heard a few months ago from Francella Simpson the "grandy" that Winston Holness was very displeased with this profusion of daughters, he wouldn't even look at the last baby when he learned it was again a girl. Francella sermoned him on God's will etc and the father somehow reconciled. ~~He has one more daughter outside child with Juliette Holness~~)

Turnica Holness is a dark-skinned plump woman with features like sculpted in granite. She is the daughter of Samuel and Catherine Senior from Ballards Valley. None of her numerous siblings live in Bull-Savannah. Her father died, long ago.

Winston Holness is the son of Uriah Holness and Jane Holness. Jane lives in the next house, with the youngest brother of Winston - Septimus. His older brother Cedrick lives with his wife and children just behind this house. Turnica told me that her mother in law is bedridden for a long time now. She had a stroke and is paralyzed.

Land. Winston got only about one acre of the home land. He has a plot of two acres in Huff House and another of about the same size in the woodlands. They work often together with the brother. The children were clamoring in the kitchen for more dinner and I had to finish the interview at that.

Turnicca Holness, nee Senior. Father: Samuel Senior /d/. Mother: Katheline Senior living now for ~~25~~ 25 years in Ballard's Valley. Has 8 brothers: Wilfred in America, Stanley in Kingston, Eustace in B. Savannah /F.R. 53/; Eglon Benjamin, Philip, Vivian and Easton in Old Harbour. ~~2~~ 2 sisters: Mehala and Esteline are living in Ballard's Valley.

Winston and Turnicca had 8 children, 7 alive. Winston has an outside child: Euline Holness. Her mother is Juliet Holness in Thatch Walk. ~~xxx~~ Euline is with her mother.

Winston went in 1944-45 to U.S.A. Repaired his home from the savings.

House, land, farming etc.

House: 2 rooms. Kitchen. Latrine. /not completed/. ~~xxxx~~ 1 buttery - not completed. Tank.

Furn.: 4 beds, 4 tables, 1 cabinet, 1 foot machine. 2 chairs.

Land: owned by Winston Holness 4.5 acres in 3 plots. 2 acres Duff House, bought from L.S. in 1940. ~~xxxx~~ 1 acre in Brednut Wood and 1.5 acre of homeland inherited from father.

Trees: 2 mangoes, 2 pears, 3 coconuts, 3 sweet saps, 3 pomegranates.

Cultiv.: Tomatoes 3000, L16. 60 yam hills. 1/2 acre cassava. 1/2 acre congo peas.

Stock: 1 donkey, 1 steer, 3 goats, 1 pig.

Spending: weekly "for meat, fish, k.oil, flour, rice, c.nut oil, etc. 6 or 60/-/?/. L30 for the past year on clothes: 8 shirts, suits, dresses, sheets, towels etc." L3.3 spent on med. treatm for Turnicca. L3 was spent on travelling to Jeh. Withn. conventions. L1 on Jeh. Withn. books. L.3 on books etc. for children /school/.

Savings: L10 kept at home.

Children in school: Daisy 6th st., Thelma 4th, Patricia 2nd, Pamela A st.

Religion: All family Jeh. Withn.
