> The living accomodations consist of 3 buildings. The main house has two rooms. Ezra is adding now one room and a verandah. The room is "for the girls, I don't like to crowd parents-and children."- said Ida. They have a spare room in the next building which is only about 4 yards from this one. The room is occupied by Vie, but will be vacated in a few days. But Ida would not let the girls sleep in a separate building. "Not girls for boys it is all right, but girls you must have them near you." The house was built by Ezra in 1925. He remembers 1t well. He had a carpenter and a mason to build it. He was 23 at the time - so he says. The next building he made was the kitchen. It is a spaclous kitchen with benches and a table to eat on - which is extremely rare in Bull -Savannah.
