Visit at home. Inter. Panton and Alma Rochester. 18.6.48.

I met Mr. Panton in his garden which is well kept. He invited me to the bigger tworoom house. We entered the "hall" which is conventionally and well furnished. Photographs on the smaller table. In the adjoining room I could hear women's voices and somebody sewing on a machine. Mr. Panton went there and asked his wife to come and meet me. Mrs. Alma was well dressed- for a week day - . She complained of a pain in her side and leg. It seemed by her description a sciatich pain. he said she went to the doctor in "andeville "He is not really a doctor but he can help people". Her sister Francella Rochester went to him and he helped her. The "doctor" said It was a kidney trouble and gave irs. Rochester some medecine but it did not help her. She rather enjoyed taking of her bad health and pain but after a while I managed to switch the conversation on other subjects. Family overseas. Mrs. Alma's sister Rebecca Grace went to Panama many years ago. Neither Panton nor Alma remember how long ago it was. She was an "average woman" 30 years old when she went there. She left Bull-Savannah because she wanted "to go and work for her living". In Panama she married a Jamaican His job was "to write in books when ships come". they had one child - a son. This sister died about 5 years ago, Mr.& Mrs. Rochester showed me with price a photograph of the sister in a coffin with husband son and friends round it. I spotted the husband and son on this rather macabre picture by the grieved expression of their face. This sister used to write "all the time during her life time and she helped the family a lot". Since her death the husband floes not write to the family, whom he never met, neither does the son. I asked Trs. Alma whether her sister seemed happy in her life abroad. Ars. Alma said that judging by the letters she was satisfied with ther life in ranama. "She did well". (Was prosperous there). hey showed me also the picture of their daug/hter Lucillesabelle who went to America a few years ago. She went there to Alma's sister Nicola. Lucille married in America not long ago. She has a baby. Does not intend to return to xwericaBull-Savannah and "rs. Almā does not expect her to come on a visit soon. Her husband is a Jamaican but American citizen. The daughter writes to her parents often - about once in a month. "ext they showed me the picture of the son Isaac, who went on contract to U.S.A. "e works in onneticut, not far from where his sister lives and they see each other quite often. The son writes also often and sends presents. He wrote lately that he sent some medecine for his mother's leg "to rubb in". On the whole both Panton and Alma are rather satisfied that two of their children are abroad. "Have better living there". They expect the son to teturn has as he is on contract "It is the law (that he should return) unless he marry there". I asked whether he did not intend to marry the mother of his KHAKKHE

Ida Rochester, but they refrained from giving any opinion on the subject. I had the feeling they would rather see him marry and settle in the U.S.A.

They were not so interested to speak about their other children who are with them at home and switched all the time the conversation to the two who are in America. They told me that Isaac was very popular in Bull-Savannah he was the captai of the cricket clyb and also took part in other organizations. "He is very popular here".

The garden, the house (at least what I have seen of at) and the way those two were clad gave an air of prosperity and good management. Panton is rather suspitious and avoided the slightest hints about his economic affairs. I did not press the point. Very often at the second visit are much easier. They invited me to come again.
