She has two aunts in Bull Savannah . They are Sarah Heath and Caroline Heath. They are her mother's sisters.

She was married to Coley from Coley Ville, near Mandeville. She has three children alive. She could not say if any died. She has a son living at Alligator Pond a daughter at Ploughdon, and a daughter who is married and living in Kingston.

They come to visit her manti sometimes and takes littlepresents for her. She is not very sensible, she does silly things most of the time. She was quite well, but after she was married and started to have children, she began to act stupid. Sometimes she walks about and begs. The Government supports her.

Her husband died long ago . Her husband's family robbed her of all that the husband left for her , so she had to come back to Bull Savannah .

Means of living.

Alice Coley lives alone in her hut. The land bround belonged previously to her husband and after his death to her. Namx She sold the land to Albert Simpson, who allowed her to built her hut on this land and to live here. The first house was blow down in 1943 or 1944.
