4. Regie Powell - "e is now living in Thatch Walk, with one girl Gladys Rowe, Charles Rowe daughter. He is living with the girl in her father home." He Regie "cultivates down there, he is a fisherman too." He has no boat of his own - "going with somebody else." Cf. Fam. Rec. 12.

5. Cubie Powell. "There was also one girl we call her "Cubie". That girl living in Clarendon now. She marry - dont know ~~her name~~ whom."

6. "Miss Moan". There was also another daughter of Margaret Johnson - "we call her Miss Moan - a little nickname. That girl marry somewhere in Montego Bay."

7. "There was also one boy that die. I dont know of anybody else."

Grandchildren of the house.

~~There is no grandchild living here in Clarendon now. Mavis Elliott, daughter of Cubie, is now staying with the grandmother. Salmon Pansy, who was her daughter, is also now with the mother, who is with the grandmother.~~

No "grannies" are living at present with the grandmother in her home. Mavis Elliott, who is daughter of Cubie, was with her in 1942, but she is in Clarendon with her mother. Mavis took with her Salmon Pansy, who was her daughter.

"Mavis Elliott - that girl was for Cubie, by one Elliott from Ballrad's Valley. Mavis Elliott living in Clarendon now, with her mother. Was here just recently, but went to live with the mother. Salmon Pansy was her daughter - she carried it him from Clarendon."
